

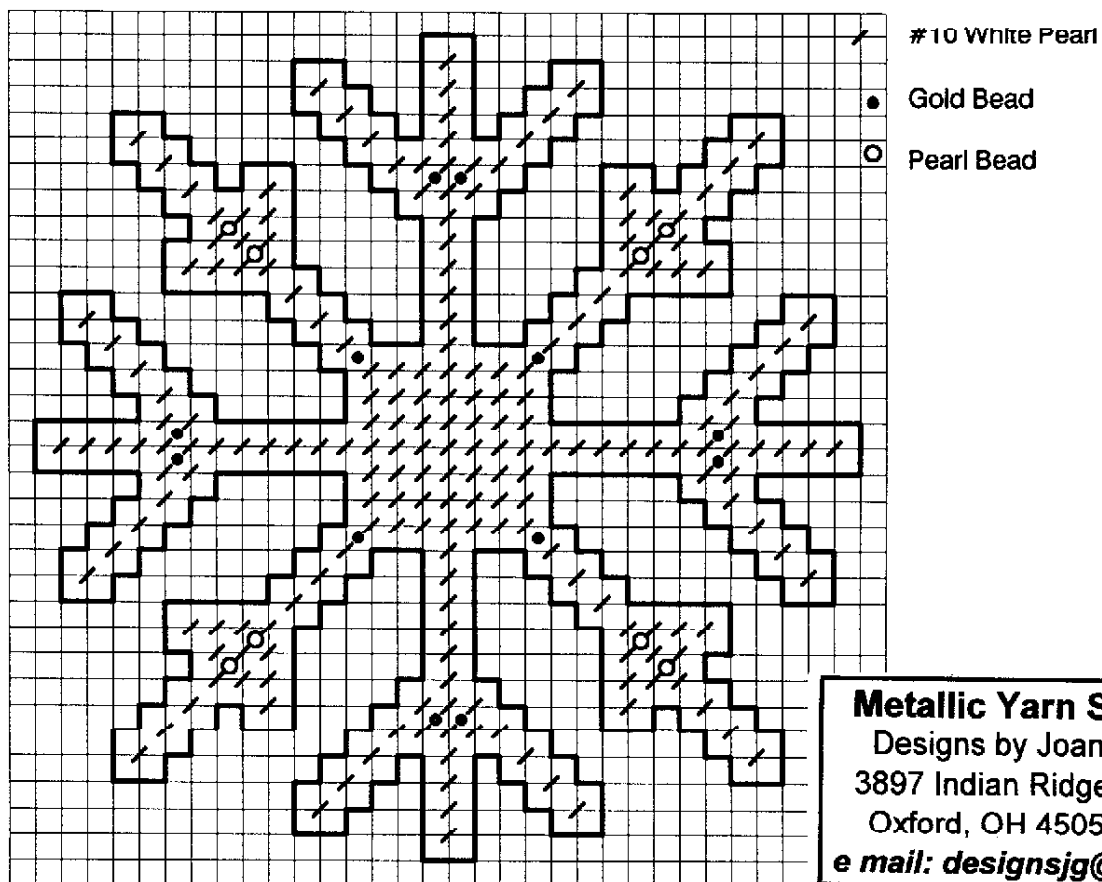
CRYSTAL FANTASY SNOWFLAKE ORNAMENT^{©1992}

A Joan Green Plastic Canvas Design for Rainbow Gallery

MATERIALS (for one two-sided ornament):

2-5½" square pieces—#7 Mesh Plastic Canvas
#16 Tapestry Needle
Plastic Canvas Metallic Yarn by Rainbow Gallery
16 yds—#10 White Pearl
24—3mm Gold Beads

16—4mm Pearl Beads
2—11mm Crystal Cabochon Gems from The Beadery
White sewing thread
#24 Tapestry Needle (for beads)
Glue Gun (Crafty Magic Melt Low Temperature Glue Gun from Ad Tech used in this project.)



**Sparkling White Pearl metallic gives your snowflake an icy glisten!
Make several for holiday decorations, tree ornaments or party gifts.**

1. Cut two pieces of canvas (32 holes x 32 holes) and trim according to dark outer lines of pattern, making two identical pieces for each ornament.
2. Work both snowflakes in Half Cross Stitch using White Pearl (#10) yarn.
3. Using the sewing thread and the #24 needle attach the beads where indicated on chart in the following manner. Knot thread ends and weave in and out of several stitches on the back side to further secure beadwork. Bring the needle up at point indicated on chart, slip the bead on the needle and insert the needle back into the same hole to attach each bead. Weave the thread up and down the arms of the snowflakes to conceal the thread when moving from one point to another.
4. Place the snowflakes back to back; sew outer edges together using White Pearl (#10) yarn and the Overcast Stitch. Attach a thread, floss or metallic yarn hanger at the top of one of the points. Glue a cabochon gem to the center of each side of the snowflake.
