

TROPICAL FISH SUNCATCHERS ^{©1994}

A Carol Krob (Carol's Creations) Design for Rainbow Gallery

MATERIALS: (for set of two, stitched on one side)
 2—28 x 31 hole pieces #7 Mesh Plastic Canvas
 #18 Tapestry Needle; Plastic Canvas Cutter

Mill Hill Pebble Beads (optional)

Plastic Canvas Metallic 7 by Rainbow Gallery

- 8 yds—PC1 Gold
- 2½ yds—PC14 Light Blue
- 2 yds—PC12 Peacock Blue
- 2 yds—PC15 Purple
- 2½ yds—PC4 Green

1. Stitch design according to chart, using Half Cross, Cross, Slanting Gobelin and straight stitches. To keep long stitches smooth and flat, guide yarn between thumb and forefinger of free hand while completing each stitch. Weave ends of yarn securely though stitching on back.
2. For eye, attach Pebble Bead with Half Cross stitch—or work a Cross Stitch in equivalent color of yarn. (Make a second Cross Stitch on top of the first for added texture.)
3. Place stitched piece on cutting surface, and trim away excess canvas, following outline of design. (Refer to solid black heavy outline on chart.) Round off sharp corners.
4. Overcast edges with Gold.

NOTE: To make two-sided suncatcher, stitch two "mirror images" and whipstitch together with Gold.

Suggestion: Make additional fish using other color combinations.

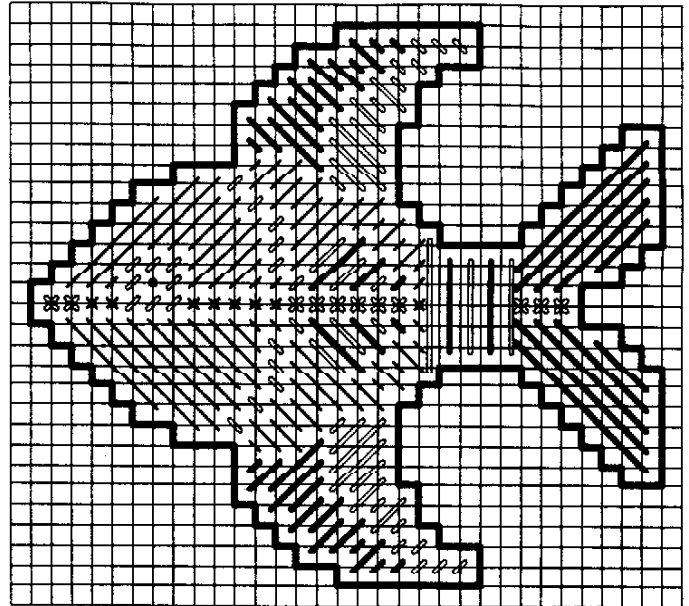
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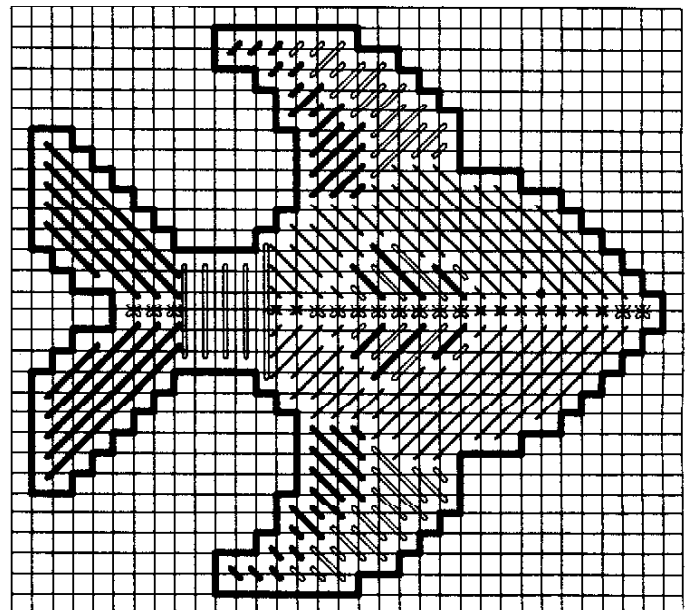
