

HEART-SHAPED HINGED TRINKET BOX^{©1994}

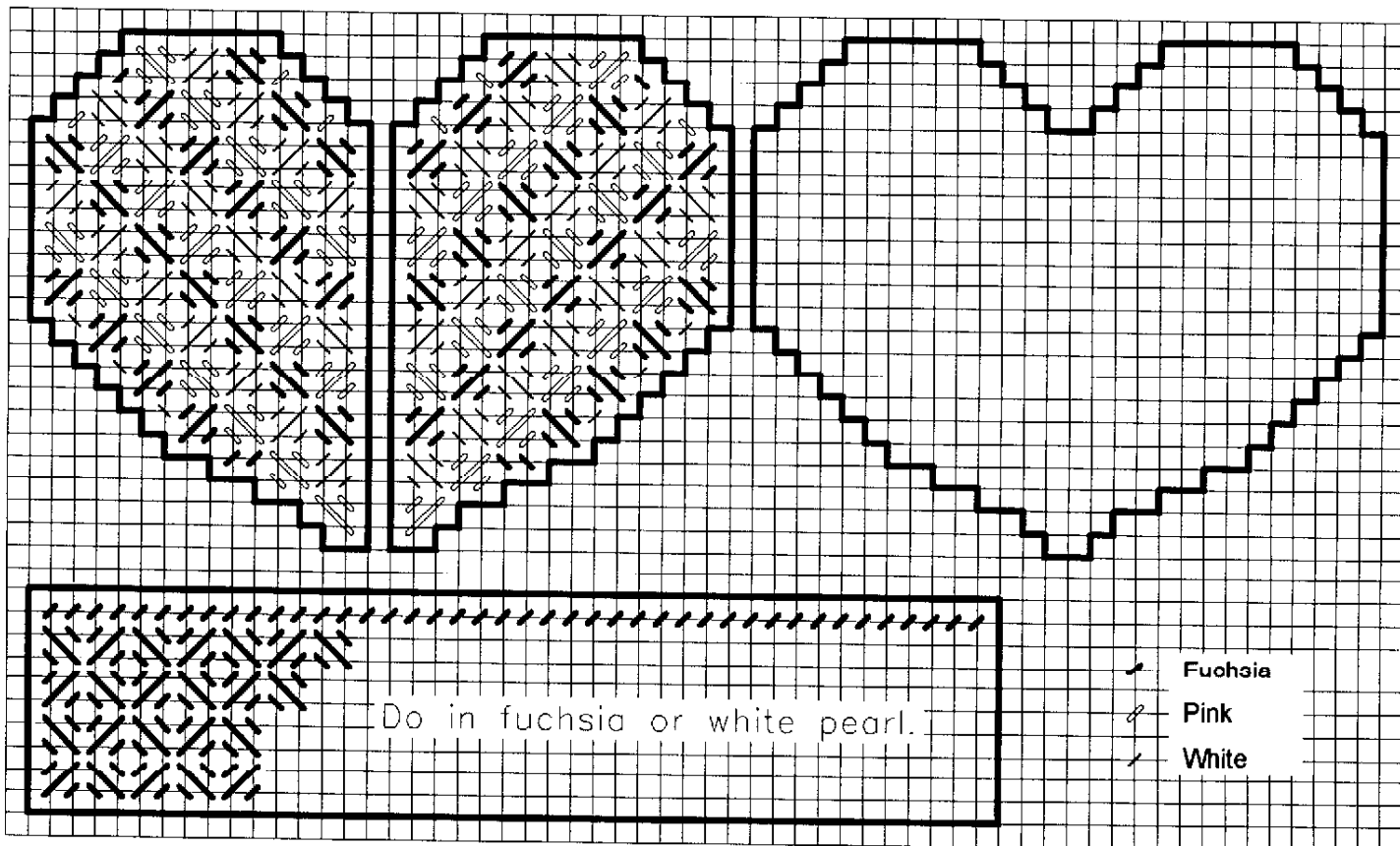
A Joan Green Plastic Canvas Design for Rainbow Gallery

MATERIALS:

- 1/4 sheet—#7 Mesh Plastic Canvas
- #16 Tapestry Needle
- Plastic Canvas Metallic 7 Yarn by Rainbow Gallery
 - 6 yds—PC8 Pink
 - 3 or 14 yds—PC10 White Pearl (Use 14 yards, if choosing this color for sides of box).
 - 3 or 14 yds—PC13 Fuchsia (Use 14 yards, if choosing this color for sides of box).
 - 18" of 1/2" wide gathered pale pink lace trim

1. Cut two pieces of canvas (15 holes x 23 holes) for top, two pieces (43 holes x 10 holes) for sides and one piece (28 holes x 23 holes) for bottom (left unstitched).
2. Work top pieces in alternating Mosaic Stitches, noting direction of all stitches. Work sides in a combination of Continental and alternating Mosaic Stitches, noting direction of stitches. Continue to fill in background in pattern as established.
3. With Fuchsia or White Pearl yarn overcast the side pieces together along one of the short edges. Now place this seam at the center indentation of the bottom heart. Overcast the side over the edge of the box bottom. Sew the other two short sides together at the lower point of the heart with same yarn.
4. Overcast the entire top edge of the piece with same color used for sides.
5. Using pink yarn, join the lid pieces together in the center, and then overcast around the edges of the two half heart shapes. Glue lace to the wrong side of the lid around the outer edge of the heart. Do each half heart separately. Tack the lid to the sides at the center indentation and bottom point of the heart. **Note:** The lid halves should remain free to open and close the box. Felt may be glued to the bottom of the lid and box if desired.
