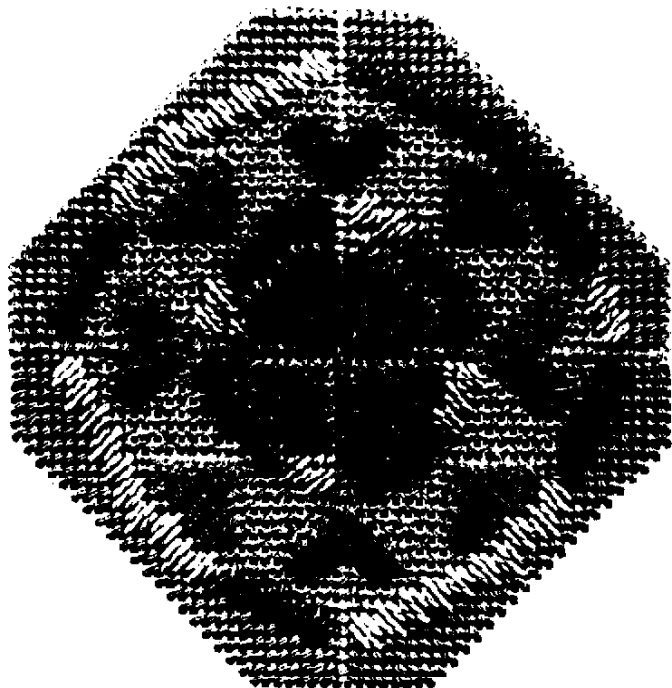


HEARTBEAT[®]

Finished size: 4" x 4"

MATERIALS

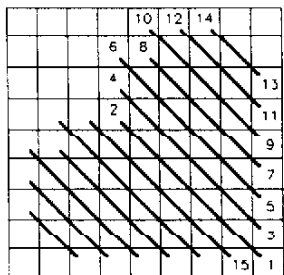
7" x 7"—#14 Mono canvas (white)
 Stretcher bars to fit
 #22 Tapestry Needle

1 card each:

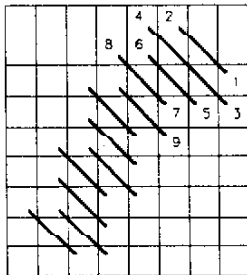
Overture[™] (V24-Reds)
 Pebbly Perle[™] (P381-Geranium)
 Frosty Rays[™] (Y071-Christmas
 Red Gloss)
 Rhapsody[™] (R33-Reds)
 Flair[™] (F530-Christmas Red)

OR pick your favorite colors

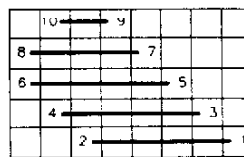
1. Find center of canvas, place one Tent Stitch in Rhapsody, then continue 27 threads in each direction from the center stitch.
2. Following the chart, work Heart #1 in center using Frosty Rays.
3. Work the Slanted Gobelin Stitches according to the chart using 1 strand Overture. Control Overture's color run by stitching mirror images, using plies from the same cut. Begin first quadrant at point "A" on Master Chart, and second at "B".
4. Work the Gobelin Hearts using Frosty Rays. Note that the first stitch shares holes with the Tent Stitch row. Work Heart #2 using Flair, following the diagram for Hearts 1 & 2.
5. Work the second series of Slanted Gobelin Stitches using 1 strand Overture. Control color as in #3. Look at the chart carefully. It is slightly different than the first row.



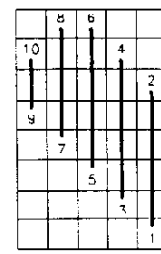

MASTER CHART—Upper Left Quarter

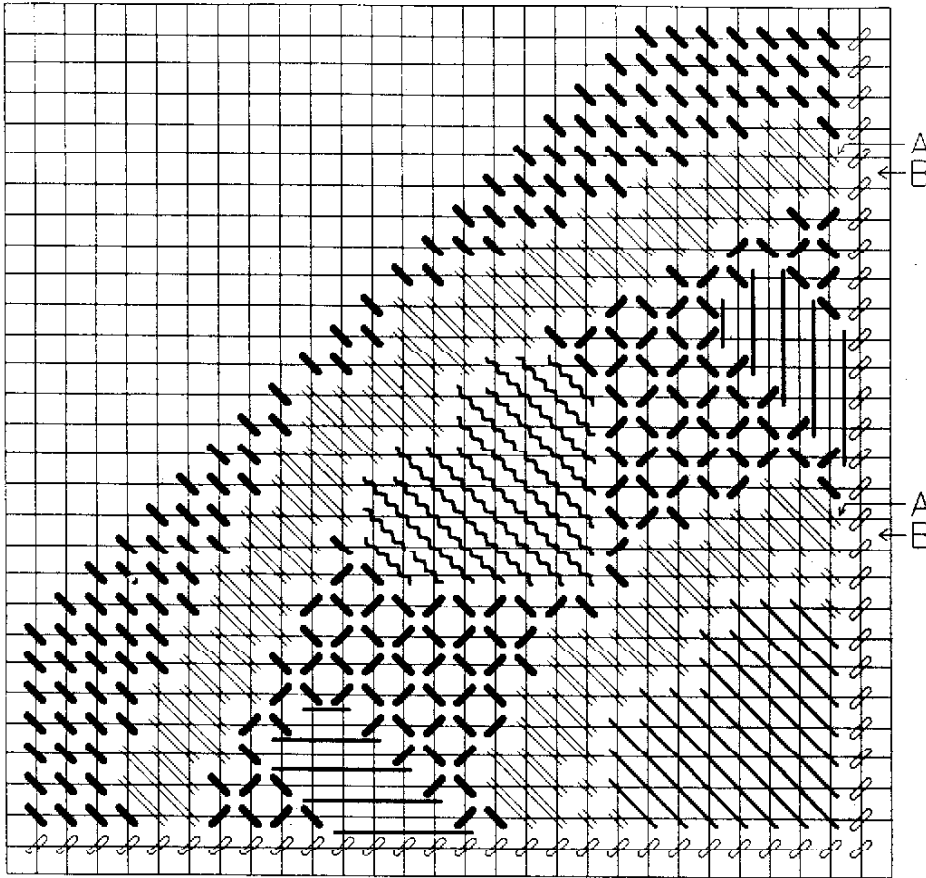
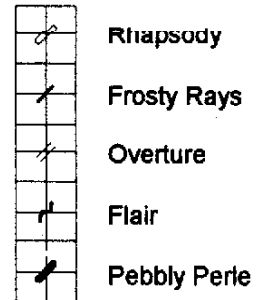
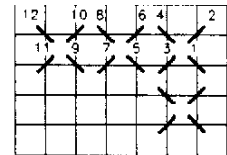


Chart shows upper left quadrant. Stitch it first, then turn your canvas so that each successive quadrant is in the upper left quadrant.



6. Fill in the area between the rows of Slanted Gobelin with Four-way Continental Stitches using 2 ply of stripped Pebbly Perle.

7. Complete the remaining area in Tent Stitch with Pebbly Perle (unstripped).
