A Joan Green Plastic Canvas Design for Rainbow Gallery

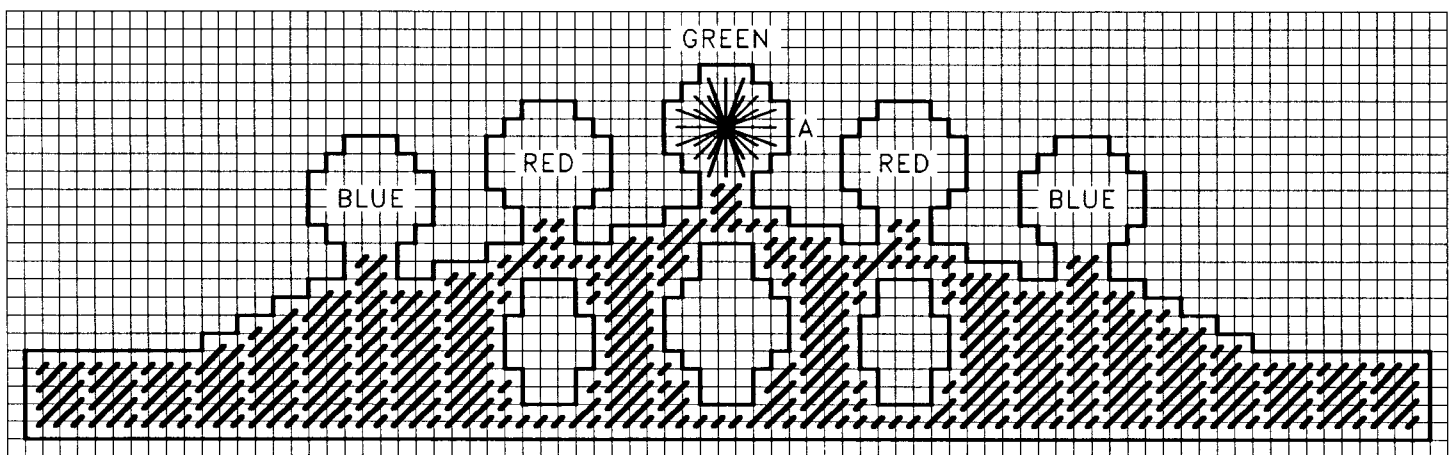
MATERIALS

- ½ sheet — #7 Mesh Plastic Canvas;
- #16 Tapestry Needle
- Plastic Canvas Metallic Yarn by Rainbow Gallery
 - 20 yds — #1 Gold
 - 2 yds — #6 Sapphire (Royal Blue)
 - 2 yds — #5 Ruby (Red)
 - 1 yd — #4 Emerald (Green)

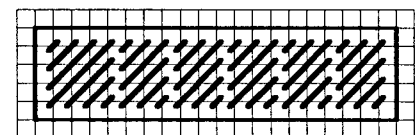
OPTIONAL MATERIAL

- 2½" strip of ¾" hook & loop tape (Velcro™)
- Glue Gun (Crafty Magic Melt Low Temperature Glue Gun from Ad Tech used in this project)

Bring delight to your favorite youngsters with this special **GOLDEN CROWN** for their birthdays or fantasy play.



1. Trim canvas pieces according to dark outer lines of pattern. Also make two of the small extension pieces. These should be 3" or longer as needed for a larger child's head. Simply repeat the pattern for the extension as necessary to cover the additional area.

2. Make long straight stitches back and forth across each jewel area, following the chart, until the area is covered front and back. This gives the jewels a raised appearance. Start at **A** on the chart and work clockwise for consistency. Carry stitching across the back diagonals as well as the front ones. Work the remainder of the Tiara in Slanting Gobelin Stitch in Gold. Note the number of intersections to be covered for each row of stitching. Be careful not to twist the yarn, to keep it flat on the canvas. Weave in all ends securely on the back side. Overcast the three cut out areas with Gold. Sew the extension pieces on either side, and then overcast the entire outer edge with Gold.
3. Glue one edge of the Velcro tape to the right side of one end and to the wrong side of the other end. Put the Tiara around the child's head first to aid you in placement of the Velcro strips. If you do not wish to use Velcro, substitute ties made from ribbon or string.
