

MEDIEVAL JEWELLED NAPKIN RINGS ^{©1992}

A Joan Green Plastic Canvas Design for Rainbow Gallery

This design may be done on either #7 or #10 Count Plastic Canvas.

MATERIALS: (for one napkin ring)

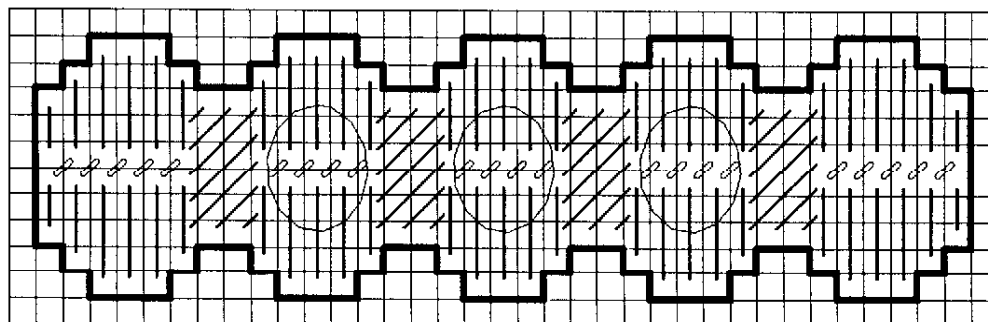
For #7 Count Napkin Ring

35 x 10 hole piece—#7 Mesh Plastic Canvas
 #16 Tapestry Needle
 Plastic Canvas Metallic 7 Yarn by Rainbow Gallery
 5 yds—PC1 Gold (or PC2 Silver)
 2 yds—PC5 Red (or other contrasting color)
 3—15mm Round Cabochon Beads from
 The Beadery (assorted colors)
 Glue Gun

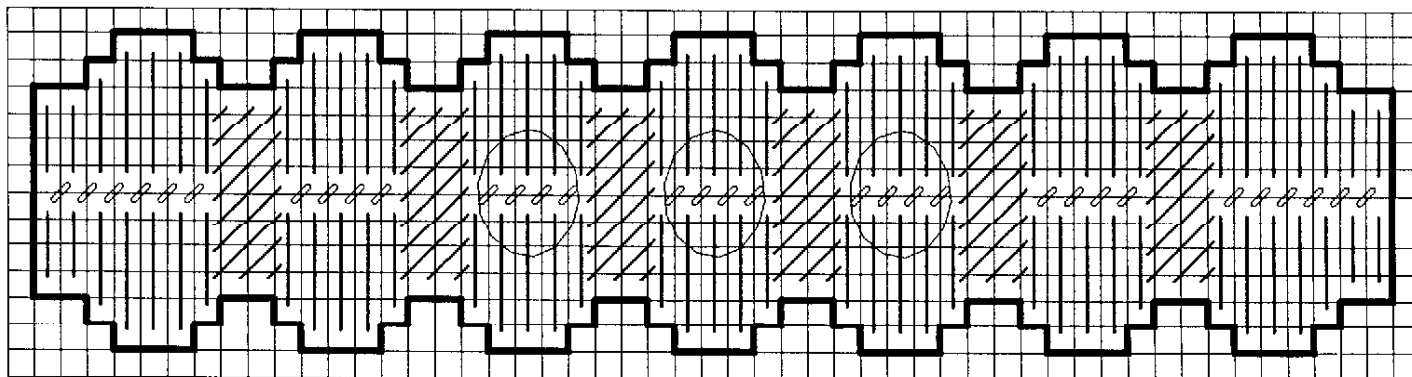
For #10 Count Napkin Ring

51 x 12 hole piece—#10 Mesh Plastic Canvas
 #20 Tapestry Needle
 Plastic Canvas Metallic 10 Yarn by Rainbow Gallery
 6 yds—PM52 Silver (or PM51 Gold)
 2 yds—PM54 Green (or other contrasting color)
 3—11mm Round Cabochon Beads from
 The Beadery (assorted colors)
 Glue Gun

1. Trim canvas pieces according to dark outer lines of charts.
2. Work from one end of the napkin ring stitching the various stitches as you come to them: Half Cross (contrasting color— ovals on chart), Slanting Gobelin and Upright Gobelin (gold or silver— thin lines on chart) are used. Overcast the two long edges in contrasting color. Finish by overcasting the short ends in gold (or silver) to form the back seam of the napkin ring.
3. Glue the Cabochon Beads in the center three sections of the napkin rings (placement marked by large light ovals on chart).
