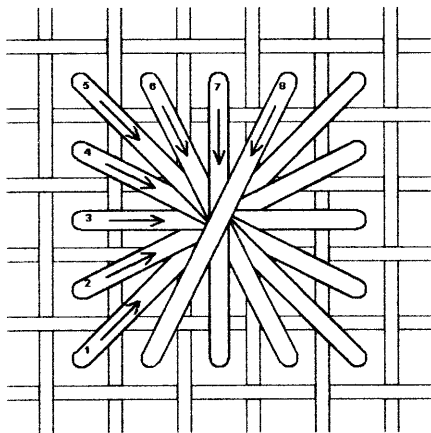
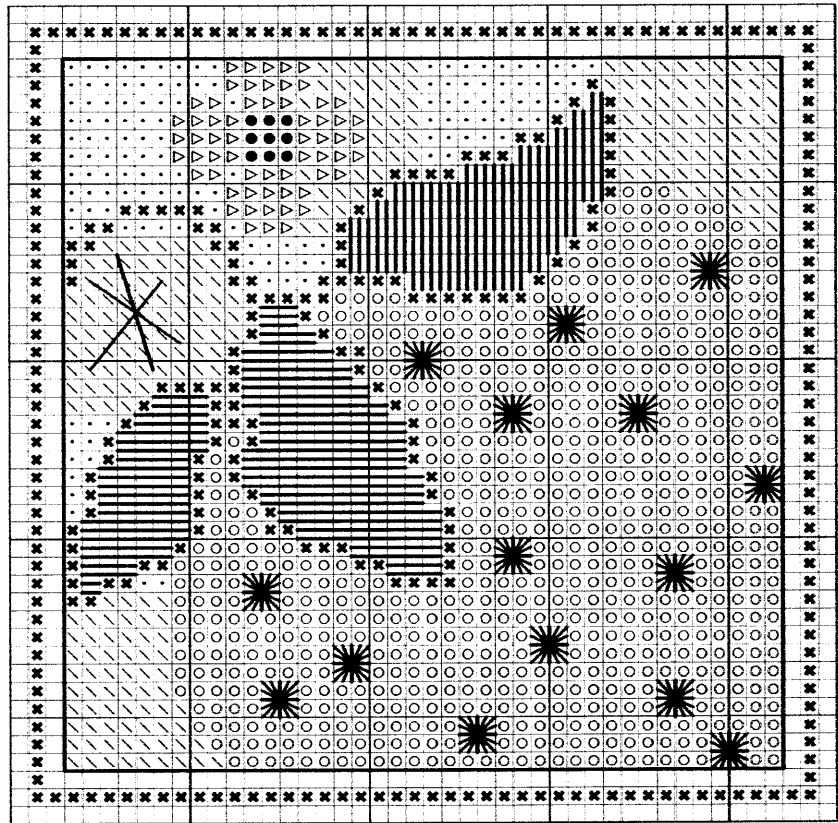


JUNE - STRAWBERRY

Stitch count: 44h x 44w – approx. 3”h x 3”w ♥ 28ct Antique Gold Country French linen from Wichelt (#86-270)
 stitched over two or 14ct Antique Gold Country French Soft Touch Aida (#367-270)



Rhodes Stitch



Rainbow Gallery Fibers - 1 card each

- ▷ E800 Elegance™ Cool White – 1 strand
- FZ23 Fuzzy Stuff Gold – 1 strand
- M809 Mandarin Floss Ruby Red – 2 ply
- ✕ RT38 Rainbow Tweed Olive – 1 ply
- S860 Splendor® Lite Sky Blue – 2 ply
- ∖ S861 Splendor® Wedgwood – 2 ply
- PB07 Treasure Braid Petite™ Red – 1 strand

After completing all cross stitches, back stitch with 1 ply Olive Rainbow Tweed around the edge of the main design area as indicated by the solid line on the chart. Use 1 strand Red Petite Treasure Braid to make Rhodes stitches over 4 threads within the strawberry. Use 1 ply Olive Rainbow Tweed to satin stitch the insides of the leaves. If you are stitching on Aida and have trouble with these extra stitches, you may fill these areas with cross stitches instead. Attach the dragonfly charm with Wedgwood Splendor® just under the strawberry stem where indicated on the chart. (*charm #12129BR from By Jupiter!*)
