

Encore Mini Pillow^{©1997}

A Rosalyn Watnemo Design for Rainbow Gallery



Finished size: 3¼" x 6"

MATERIALS

- 1—28 Ct. Mini Pillow by Adam Originals*
- 1 Card—Encore![®] E28-Granites
OR color of your choice

* Design may also be worked on any 28 Ct. fabric and framed or placed in a box lid.

Measure pillow top both ways to find center point. From this point, holding pillow horizontally, count two threads to the right and two threads up. This is the hole the needle will come up in for the first Satin Stitch block (see arrow on Master Chart).

Instructions from the Meier/Watnemo book, "Beginners Charted Hardanger Embroidery", ©1980.

1. Work Satin Stitch blocks in 1 ply Encore!. (Diagram A) Work all solid motifs.
2. Cut and withdraw 4 threads (shown by wavy lines) where indicated on Master Chart. **Never cut parallel to satin stitches.** Use 1 ply for woven bars. (Diagram B)
3. Cut a piece of lining fabric to place in pillow behind the cutwork. Stuff the pillow and you're finished!

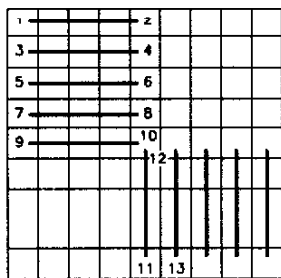


Diagram A—SATIN STITCH

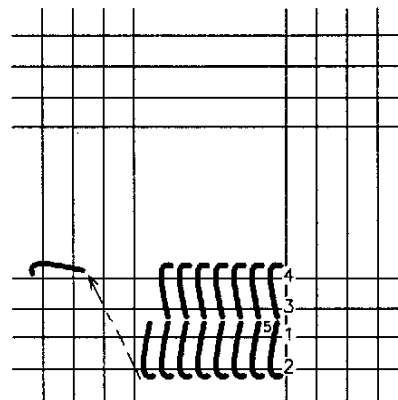


Diagram B—WOVEN BARS
