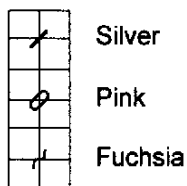


# JEWELED PHOTO FRAME <sup>©1995</sup>

for 3½ x 5" Prints

A Joan Green Plastic Canvas Design for Rainbow Gallery



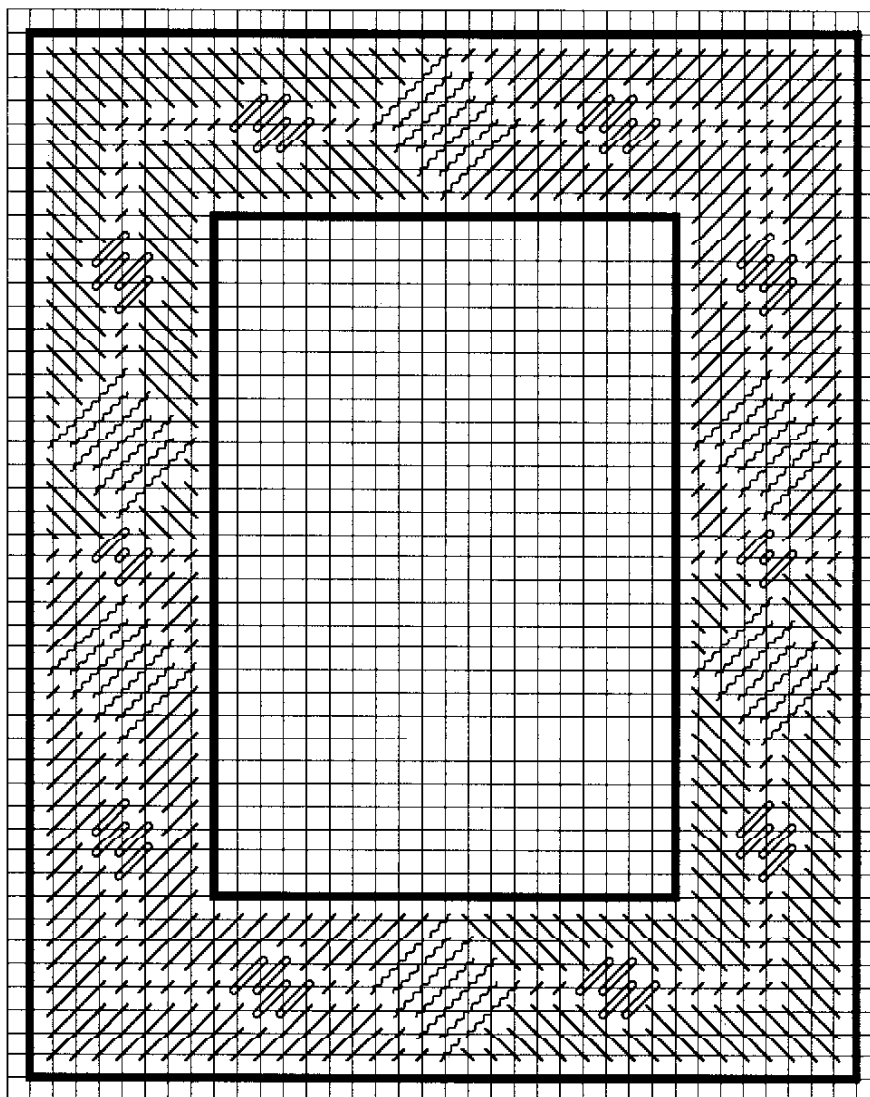
## MATERIALS:

1 sheet—#7 Mesh Plastic Canvas  
#16 Tapestry Needle

Plastic Canvas Metallic 7 yarn by  
Rainbow Gallery  
16 yds—PC2 Silver  
4 yds—PC8 Pink  
5 yds—PC13 Fuchsia

OR choose your own colors

1. Cut two pieces 36 holes x 46 holes. Leave one unstitched for the back. Carefully cut away the inner portion of the front piece following heavy lines on chart.
2. Work the Silver Continental Stitches around the middle of the border. Then work the diagonal stitches in Silver, noting the direction of the stitches.



3. Work the jewels as follows: Work the diagonal stitches as shown on the chart. Then, work directly over the stitches in the opposite direction to give a padded effect.
4. Overcast the inner edge with Silver. Place the front and back piece together and overcast the pieces together leaving one edge open for insertion of photo. (The frame may be used vertically or horizontally—leave whichever edge will be the bottom open. Simply overcast the edge of the front piece for the open edge.)

NOTE: Feel free to make your "jewels" any colors you like. The background would be very nice in Gold or White Pearl.
