

# SNOWMAN ORNAMENT <sup>©1993</sup>

## A Joan Green Plastic Canvas Design for Rainbow Gallery

This design may be done on either #7 or #10 count plastic canvas.

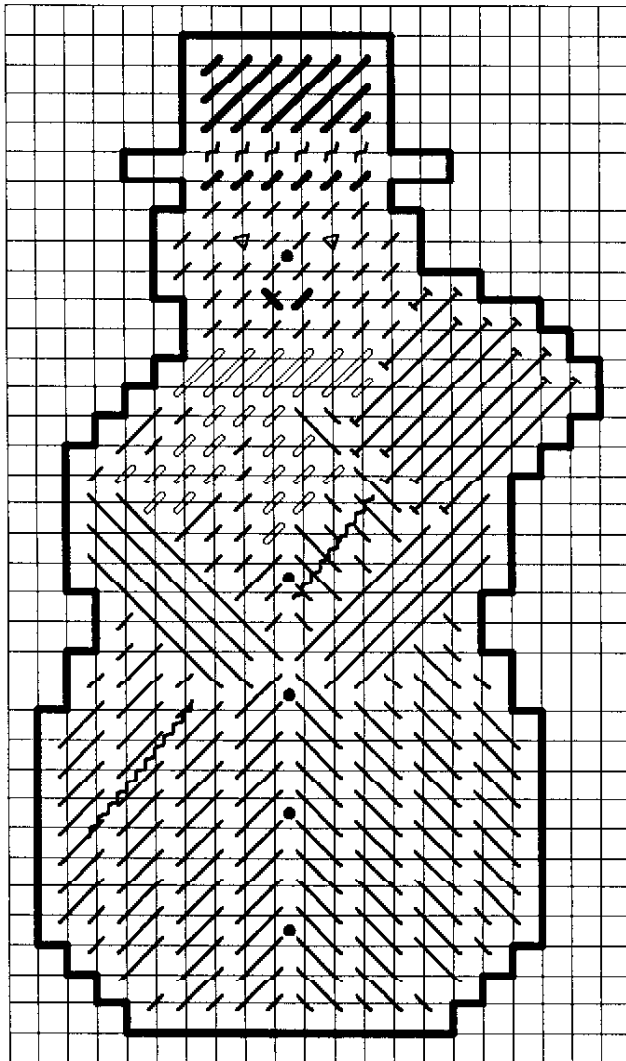
### MATERIALS:

#### For #7 Count

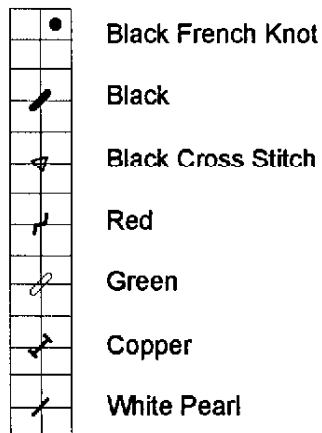
3" x 5½" piece—#7 Mesh Plastic Canvas  
 #10 Tapestry Needle  
 Plastic Canvas Metallic 7 Yarn by Rainbow Gallery  
 1 yd—PC3 Copper  
 2 yds—PC4 Green  
 1 yd—PC5 Red  
 7 yds—PC10 White Pearl  
 2 yds—PC11 Black

#### For #10 Count

2½" x 4" piece—#10 Mesh Plastic Canvas  
 #20 Tapestry Needle  
 Plastic Canvas Metallic 10 Yarn by Rainbow Gallery  
 1 yd—PM53 Copper  
 1 yd—PM54 Green  
 1 yd—PM55 Red  
 6 yds—PM70 White Pearl  
 1 yd—PM61 Black



1. Cut one piece of canvas (19 holes x 34 holes) and trim according to **dark outer lines** of pattern.
2. **NOTE:** Overcast edges with color adjacent to it at the same time that area is stitched to conserve yarn. Work the broom in long straight stitches. The top portion of the top hat, parts of the muffler and the body of the snowman are all worked in Slanting Gobelin stitch—note the direction of the stitches. Work the arms in long straight stitches, noting stitch direction. Work the remainder of the top hat, the face and tails on the muffler in Continental. Work the eyes in Cross Stitch and take short stitches for the mouth. Work the nose and buttons on the body in French Knots. Complete by taking two long straight stitches for the broom handle as shown on the chart.
3. Cut a 7" length of Red yarn, form into a loop and sew or glue to the top back side of the hat for a hanger.
