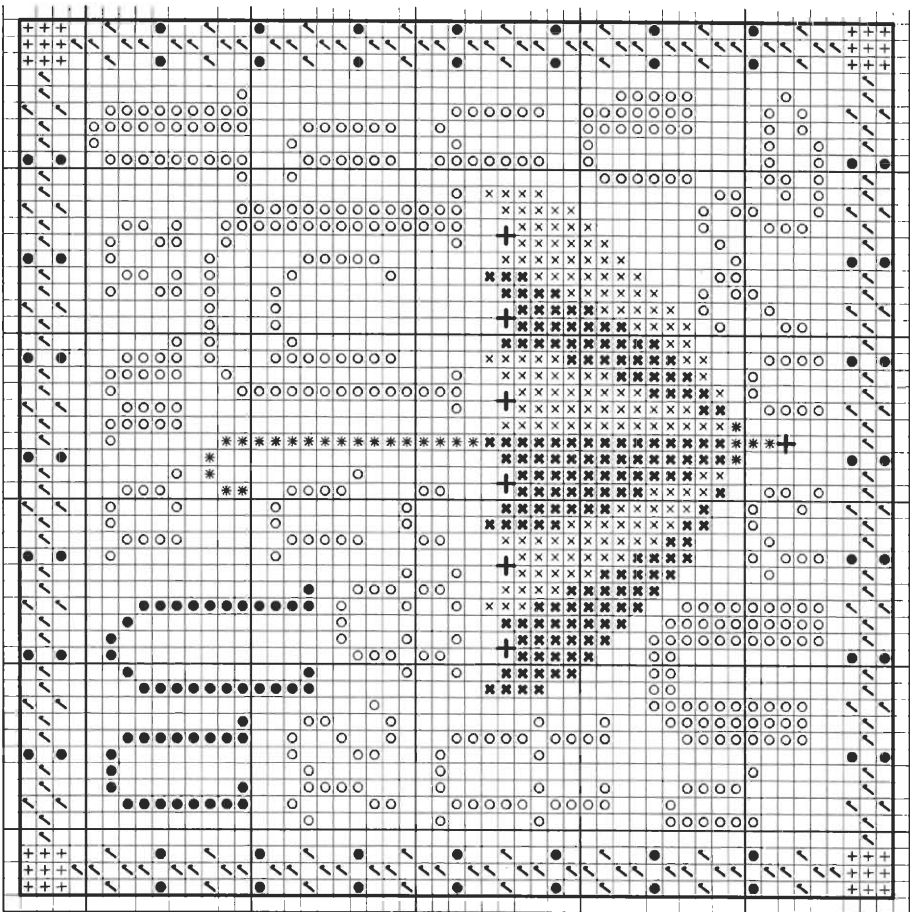


“U” is for Umbrella & the Upright Cross Stitch

Stitch count: 53h x 53w – approx. 4”h x 4”w stitched over 2 threads on 28ct Clay Cashel linen from Zweigart (#3281-715)



Rainbow Gallery Fibers - 1 card each

- ✱ A24 Bravo!® Reds – 1 ply
- ✕ A24 Bravo!® Reds – 1 ply (see directions below)
- A133 Bravo!® Shamrocks – 1 ply
- * E801 Elegance™ Black – 1 strand
- ✓ M888 Mandarin Floss Lite Electric Blue – 2 ply
- P62 Pebbly Perle® Dark Amethyst – 1 ply
- + P62 Pebbly Perle® Dark Amethyst – 1 ply with Upright Cross Stitches

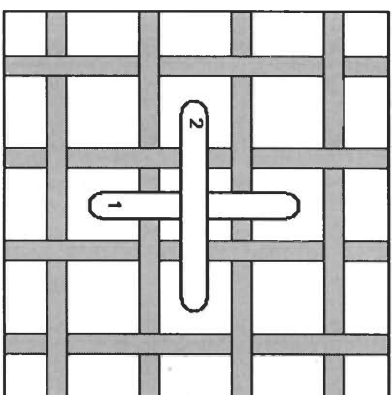
There are 2 symbols designated for the “Reds” Bravo! thread – the entire umbrella is stitched with A24 Reds, but each panel of the umbrella is cross stitched separately to help define the panels a bit more. Make upright cross stitches using 1 ply of A133 Shamrocks to accent the scallops of the umbrella and also at the very top. (As an option, also stitch the ● symbols in the border using the upright cross stitch.) Make blocks of upright cross stitches in each corner of the border using 1 ply of P62 Dark Amethyst (shown by the + symbols).
After completing all of the cross stitches, backstitch around the entire design with 1 ply of A24 Reds.

To get the complete effect of the variegation in the Bravo! threads, work each cross stitch as you go.

Upright Cross Stitch

Also called the “straight cross”, this is a very old and simple stitch that is usually worked from left to right with each cross completed as you progress.

NOTE: Grid lines in stitch diagram represent one thread of your evenweave or linen fabric.
