

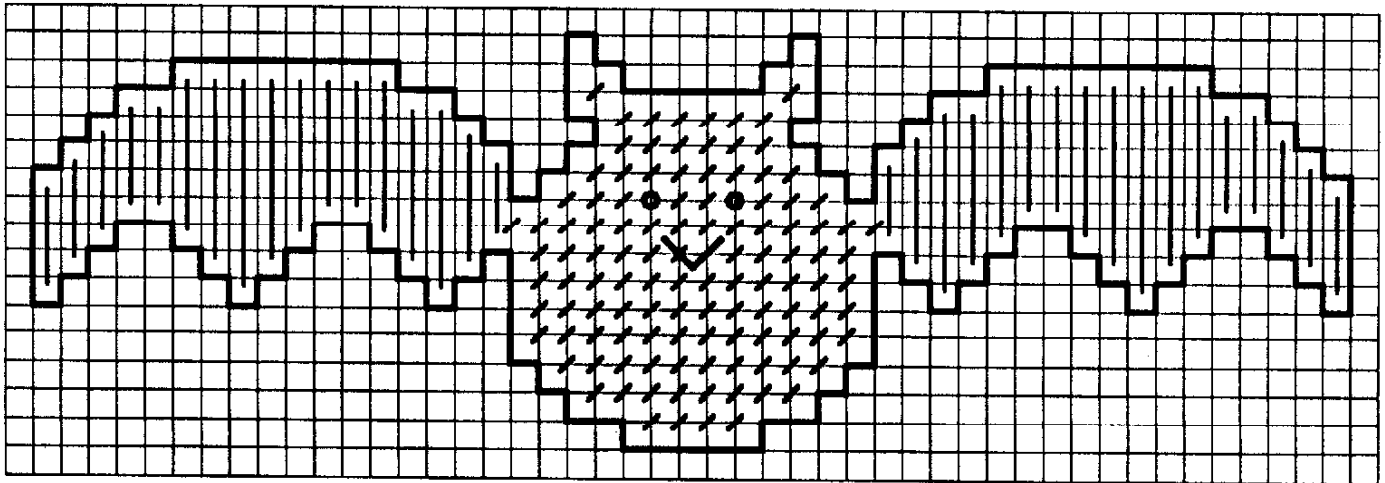
# BAT ORNAMENT<sup>©1992</sup>

A Joan Green Plastic Canvas Design for Rainbow Gallery

## MATERIALS:

7½" x 3" piece—#7 Mesh Plastic Canvas  
#16 Tapestry Needle

Plastic Canvas Metallic Yarn by Rainbow Gallery  
7 yds—PC11 Black  
Few inches—PC2 Silver



Look for these companion Halloween designs:

• Ghost Ornament • Jack-O-Lantern Ornament

For your enjoyment Rainbow Gallery offers many other free project sheets including Snowflakes, Christmas Ornaments and more.

1. Cut one piece of canvas (47 holes x 15 holes) and trim according to the dark outer lines of pattern.
2. Work wings in long straight stitches and body in Continental Stitch with PC11 Black. Work the eyes (circles on chart) in Cross Stitch with PC2 Silver and take two straight stitches (heavy lines on chart) for the mouth—also in PC2.
3. Attach a hanger for use as an ornament. Optional uses: Make several and suspend from a mobile. Glue to Trick or Treat tote bags or to a small wicker basket of Halloween treats. Glue to a plastic card holder to make a plant poke or glue a magnet strip to the back side for use as a refrigerator magnet.
