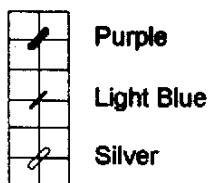


# METALLIC QUILT BLOCK FRIDGIES OR ORNAMENTS <sup>©1994</sup>

## MATERIALS:

1/4 sheet—#7 Mesh Plastic Canvas  
#16 Tapestry Needle

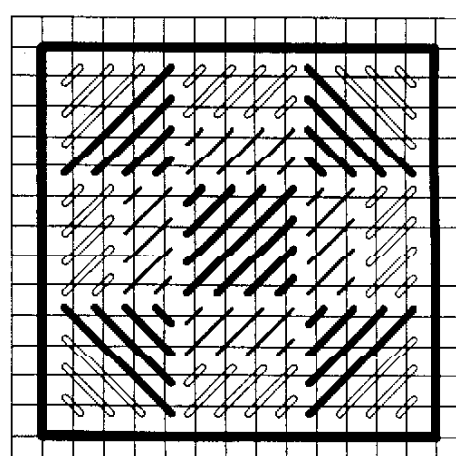
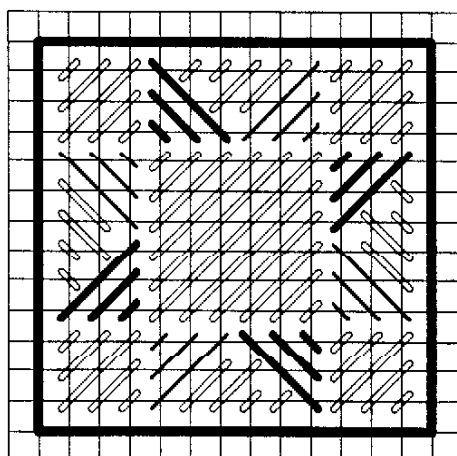
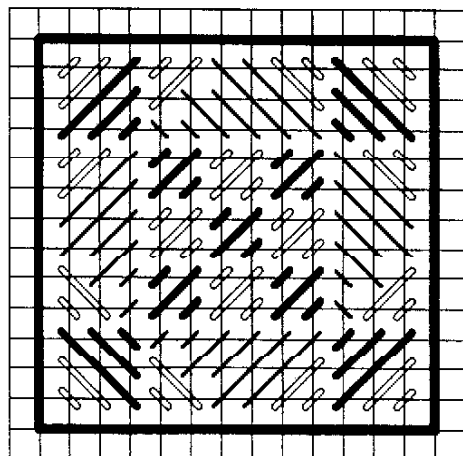
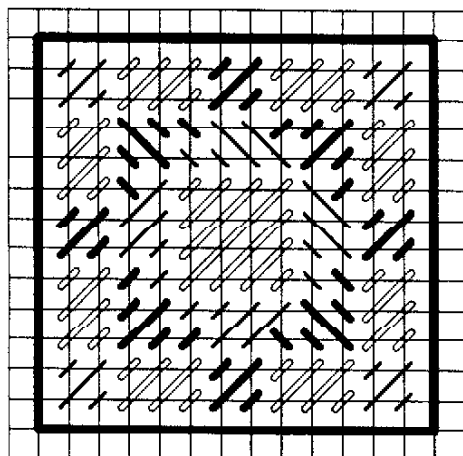
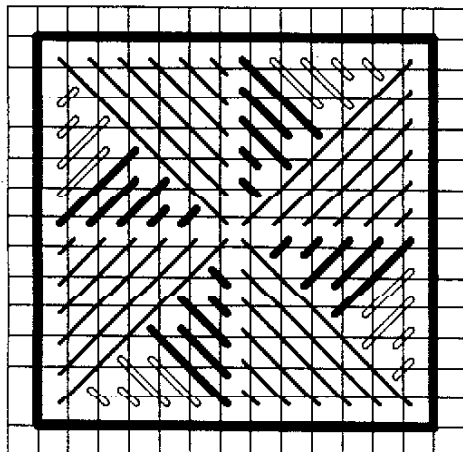
5—1" magnet strips

Plastic Canvas Metallic 7 by Rainbow Gallery

10 yds—PC2 Silver  
5 yds—PC14 Light Blue  
5 yds—PC15 Purple

1. Cut five pieces 13 holes x 13 holes.
2. Work fridgies/ornaments in long straight stitches noting direction of stitches.
3. Overcast the edges with Silver.
4. Glue a 1" magnet strip to the back of each fridgie.

NOTE: Be creative and try different color combinations using a dark, a medium and a light. Red, Green and Light Gold would be great for Christmas. (Other possibilities: Black, Copper and White Pearl; Purple, Fuchsia and Gold; Forest Green, Fuchsia and Gold, etc.)
