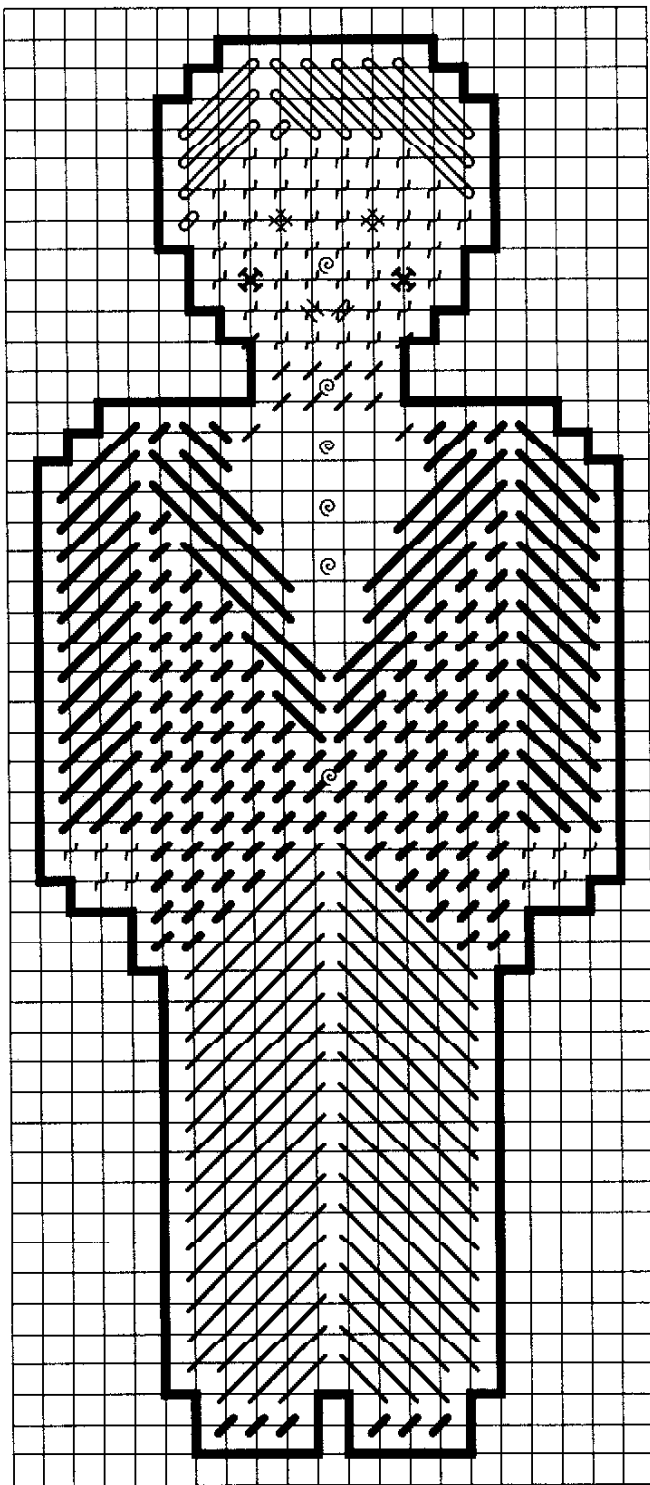


# GROOM ORNAMENT <sup>©1995</sup>

A Joan Green Plastic Canvas Design for Rainbow Gallery



## MATERIALS:

- 1/6 sheet— #7 Mesh Plastic Canvas
- #16 Tapestry Needle
- 1—tiny pink satin ribbon rose (Wrights Roses Per Yard)

## Plastic Canvas Metallic 7 yarn by Rainbow Gallery

- 5 yds—PC11 Black
- 4 yds—PC16 Pewter
- 1 yd—PC10 White Pearl
- 1/2 yd—PC1 Gold

## Worsted weight yarn

- 2 yds—Pale Flesh
- 1 yd—Sandy Brown (or color of your choice)
- Tiny bit of Dark Brown and Medium Rose

1. Cut one piece 19 holes x 47 holes. Trim according to dark outer line of chart.
2. Work hair in diagonal stitches using Sandy Brown yarn, overcasting edges at the same time. Work face and hands in Pale Flesh, overcasting those edges at the same time. Take Cross Stitches for cheeks using Rose. Separate Dark Brown Into 2 plies and work eyes in Cross Stitch, nose in a French Knot and backstitch the mouth.
3. Work bow tie in Continental stitches using Pewter. Overcast the edges at the same time and make a French Knot in the center of the bow. Work trousers in long diagonal stitches and overcast edges. Work shirt in White Pearl. Make French Knots in Gold for buttons. Finish by working tuxedo jacket in Black as follows—sleeves are long diagonal stitches (note direction of stitches); work the lapels in the same fashion. Finish rest of jacket in Continental. Make a double French Knot (wrap twice around needle) for the jacket button. Overcast jacket edges with Black. Work shoes in Black and overcast those edges.
4. Glue rosebud to lapel for boutonniere.
