## A Carol Krob (Carol's Creations) Design for Rainbow Gallery

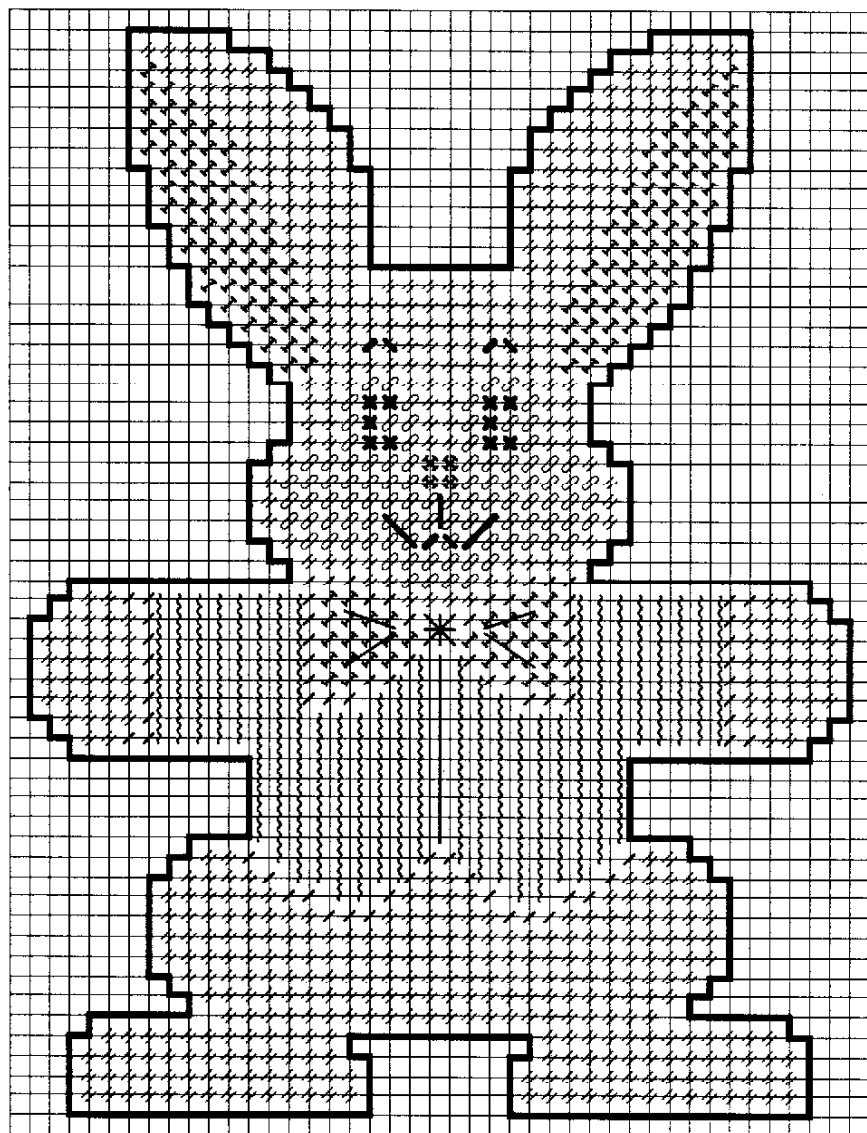
### MATERIALS:

1—41 x 55 hole piece #7 Mesh Plastic Canvas  
#18 Tapestry Needle; Plastic Canvas Cutter  
Plastic Canvas Metallic 7 by Rainbow Gallery  
9½ yds—PC14-Lite Blue (or PC3-Copper)  
3 yds—PC8-Pink

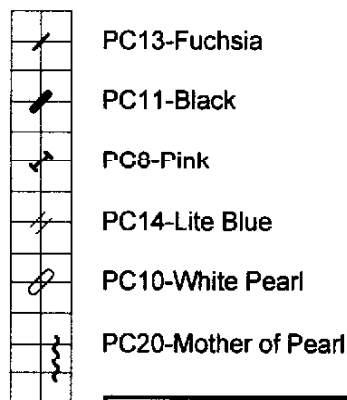
2 yds—PC10-White Pearl  
2 yds—PC13-Fuchsia  
1 yd—PC11-Black  
3 yds—PC20-Mother of Pearl  
4 yds—PC1-Gold

This colorful Bunny will add a cheerful touch to your Easter decor. To make an "All Seasons" version, substitute Copper for the Light Blue. If you like, stitch several Bunnies and join their hands together—then let them parade across a shelf, sideboard or mantle.

1. Stitch design according to chart, using Half Cross, Cross and Straight Stitches. To keep yarn smooth and flat, guide it between thumb and forefinger of free hand while completing each stitch. Anchor all ends securely beneath stitches on back before clipping.



2. Add straight stitches (Black on face and Fuchsia on bow) on top of other stitches. Work straight stitch down center of jacket with Fuchsia.
3. To make Smyrna Crosses in center of bow, work a large Cross Stitch over two mesh and then work an Upright Cross on top.
4. Place stitched piece on cutting surface and trim away excess canvas, following outline of design. Refer to solid heavy outline on chart. Round off sharp corners.
5. Overcast edges with Gold.
