A Carol Krob (Carol's Creations) Design for Rainbow Gallery

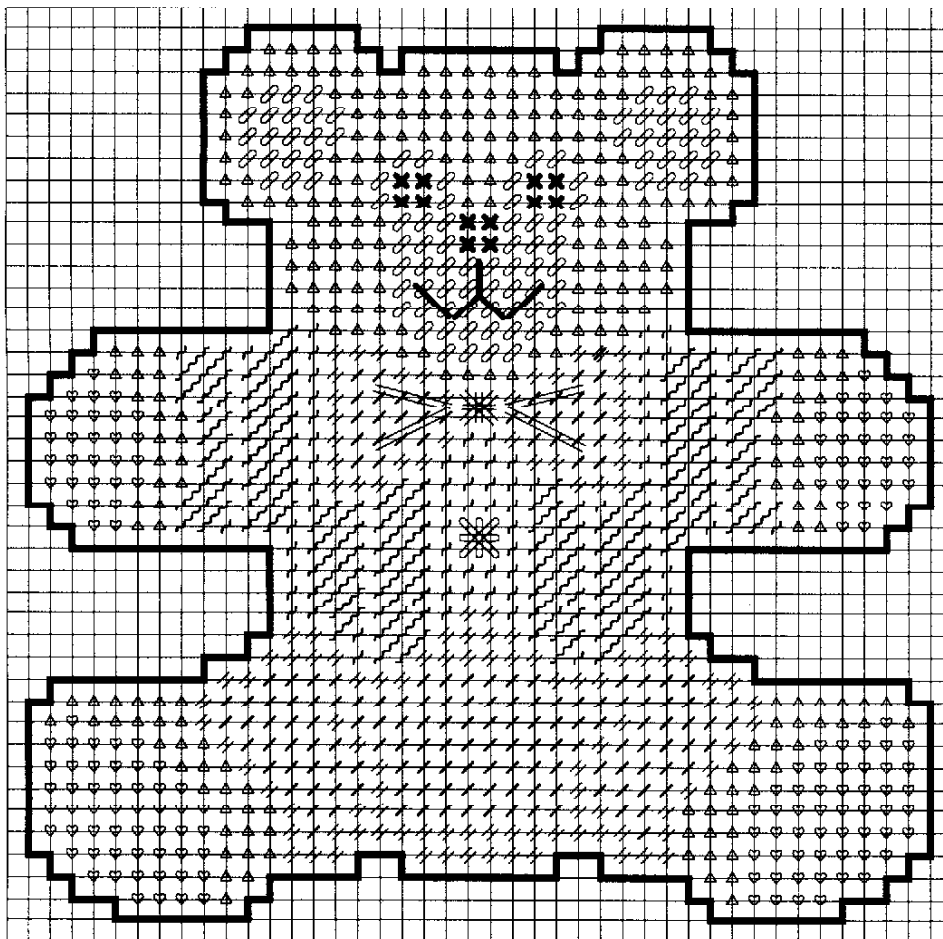
MATERIALS:

1—41 x 41 hole pieces #7 Mesh Plastic Canvas
#18 Tapestry Needle; Plastic Canvas Cutter

For a special **FURRY** look, substitute Precious Metals for PC3 and PC21. PM3-Copper—1 card; PM4-Bronze—2 cards. Stitch this yarn doubled.

Plastic Canvas Metallic 7 by Rainbow Gallery
5 yds—PC1-Golds
3 yds—PC3-Copper
5 yds—PC21-Bronze
1 yd—PC11-Black
3 yds—PC19-Blue
4 yds—PC14-Lite Blue
4 yds—PC5-Christmas Red

1. Stitch design according to chart, using Half Cross, Cross and Slanting Gobelin Stitches. To keep yarn smooth and flat, guide it between thumb and forefinger of free hand while completing each stitch. Anchor all ends securely beneath stitches on back before clipping.
2. Add straight stitches (Black on face and Blue on bow) on top of other stitches.
3. To make Smyrna Crosses (Blue in center of bow and Gold in center of jacket), work a large Cross Stitch over two mesh and then work an Upright Cross on top.
4. Place stitched piece on cutting surface and trim away excess canvas, following outline of design. Refer to solid heavy outline on chart. Round off sharp corners.
5. Overcast edges with Gold. A loop for hanging may be made from a 9" length of Gold yarn.
