

NUTCRACKER KING ^{©1995}

A Joan Green Plastic Canvas Design for Rainbow Gallery

MATERIALS:

1/4 sheet—#7 Mesh Plastic Canvas
#16 Tapestry Needle

Plastic Canvas Metallic 10 yarn by Rainbow Gallery
1 yd—PM51 Gold
1 yd—PM61 Black
Worsted Weight Yarn
2 yds—Pale Flesh

Plastic Canvas Metallic 7 yarn by Rainbow Gallery
3 yds—PC12 Peacock
2 yds—PC15 Purple
2 yds—PC13 Fuchsia
2 yds—PC1 Gold
2 yds—PC14 Light Blue
2 yds—PC10 White Pearl
1 1/2 yds—PC11 Black

1. Cut one piece 20 holes x 44 holes. Trim according to dark outer line of chart.
2. Work the following areas in Continental Stitch: crown, face, nose, mouth (nutcracker), sleeves, hands, jacket, belt and boots. Work hair in diagonal stitches, noting the direction of the stitches. Work beard in long vertical stitches and trousers in Slanting Gobelin, noting direction of stitches. Work the jewels on the crown in French Knots. Using the lighter weight yarns, outline the mouth and work eyebrows, designs on the sleeves, eyebrows and mustache. Make French Knots for the eyes. Overcast all edges with the color adjacent to the edge.
3. Cut a 7" piece of yarn and glue to the top back side to use as an ornament.

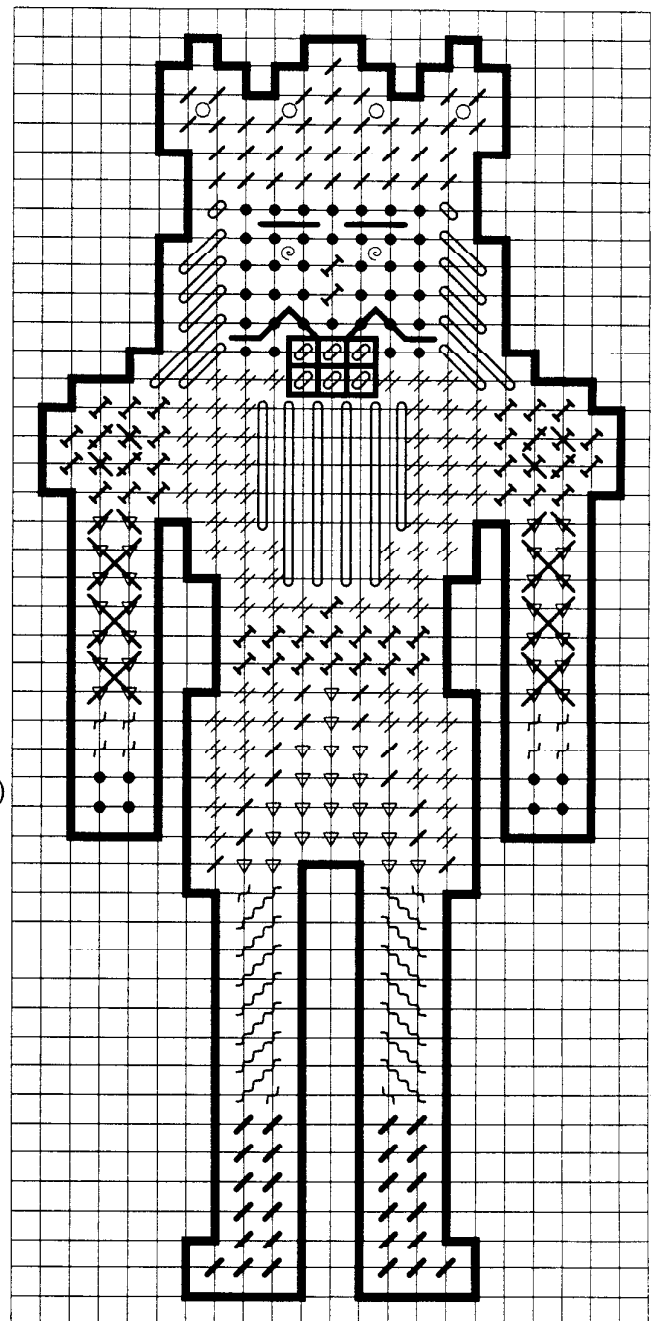
