

# MINI FLORALS—MAGNETS or PLANT POKES ©1997

A Carol Krob (Carol's Creations) Design for Rainbow Gallery

## MATERIALS:

3—17 x 18 hole piece #7 Mesh Plastic Canvas  
#18 Tapestry Needle, Plastic Canvas Cutter

Plastic Canvas Metallic 7 yarn by Rainbow Gallery

1½ yds—PC18-Dark Gold

½ yd—PC17-Forest Green

1½ yds—Dark Color: PC15-Purple, PC5-Red or PC12- Peacock

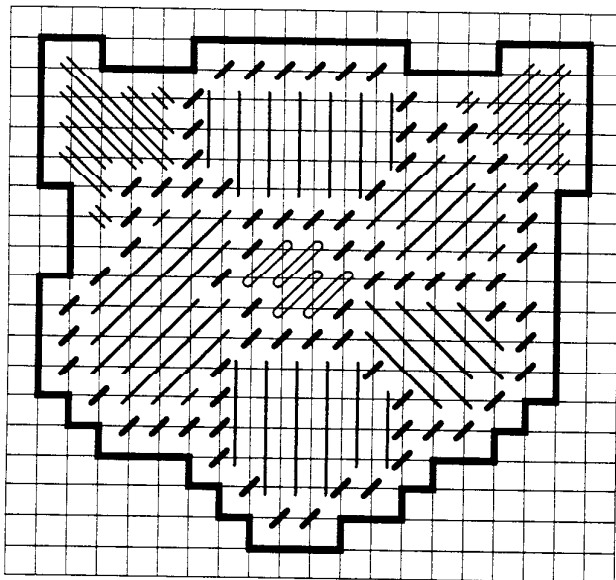
1½ yds—Light Color: PC23-Lilac, PC22-Peach or PC24-Aqua

Self-adhesive 1" Magnets **OR** slender dowels (cut to desired length)

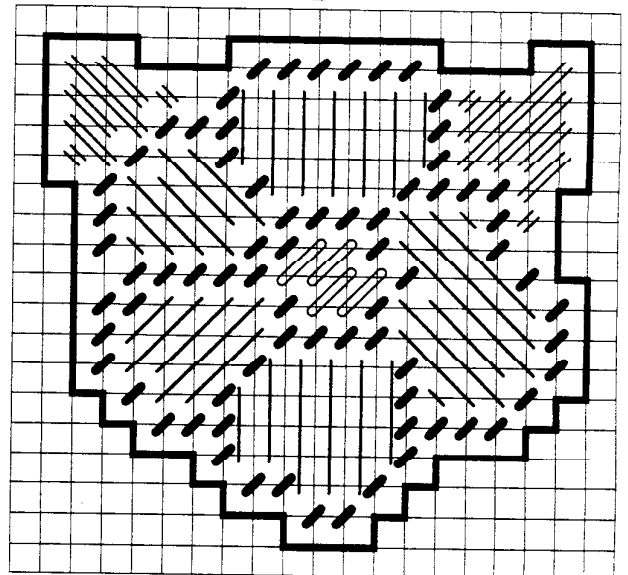
Create a cheery indoor garden of posies to enjoy all year long. Stitch several in each color to finish as magnets, plant pokes or other decorations.

1. Stitch design according to chart using Half-cross, Slanting Gobelin and straight stitches. For flower petals, use Purple- Lilac, Red-Peach or Peacock-Aqua. To keep long stitches smooth and flat, guide yarn between thumb and forefinger of free hand while drawing it through the canvas.
2. With plastic canvas cutter, trim away excess canvas, following outline of stitched design. Round off sharp corners.
3. For magnets: Overcast edges with Dark Gold and attach magnet to back. For plant pokes: Stitch two flowers (A and B). Trim away excess canvas and overcast lower edge of each flower with Dark Gold. Whipstitch together along side and top edges. Insert dowel through opening in bottom.
