

# NUTCRACKER SERGEANT <sup>©1995</sup>

A Joan Green Plastic Canvas Design for Rainbow Gallery

## MATERIALS:

1/4 sheet—#7 Mesh Plastic Canvas  
#16 Tapestry Needle

Plastic Canvas Metallic 10 yarn by Rainbow Gallery  
2 yds—PM51 Gold  
Tiny bit—PM61 Black  
Worsted Weight Yarn  
2 yds—Pale Flesh

Plastic Canvas Metallic 7 yarn by Rainbow Gallery

3 1/2 yds—PC5 Red  
3 yds—PC15 Purple  
2 yds—PC1 Gold  
2 yds—PC4 Green  
1 yd—PC21 Bronze  
1 yd—PC11 Black  
Tiny bit—PC10 White Pearl

1. Cut one piece 20 holes x 46 holes. Trim according to dark outer line of chart.
2. Work the following areas in Continental Stitch: head piece, face nose, mouth (nutcracker), upper sleeves, cuffs, hands, belt, skirt, hem and boots. Work hair, upper jacket and middle portion of sleeves in diagonal stitches, noting the direction of the stitches. Work beard in long vertical stitches. Using the lighter weight yarns, outline the mouth and work eyebrows and designs on head piece and upper sleeves. Work French Knots for the eyes and the dots on the upper sleeves and skirt. Overcast all edges with the color adjacent, but use gold for the belt and sides of skirt hem and purple for lower hem.
3. Cut a 7" piece of yarn and glue to the top back side to use as an ornament.
