A Joan Green Plastic Canvas Design for Rainbow Gallery

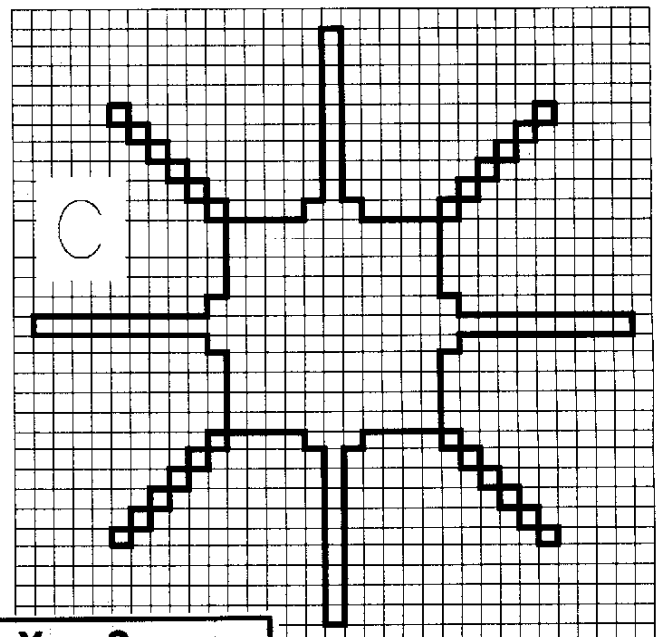
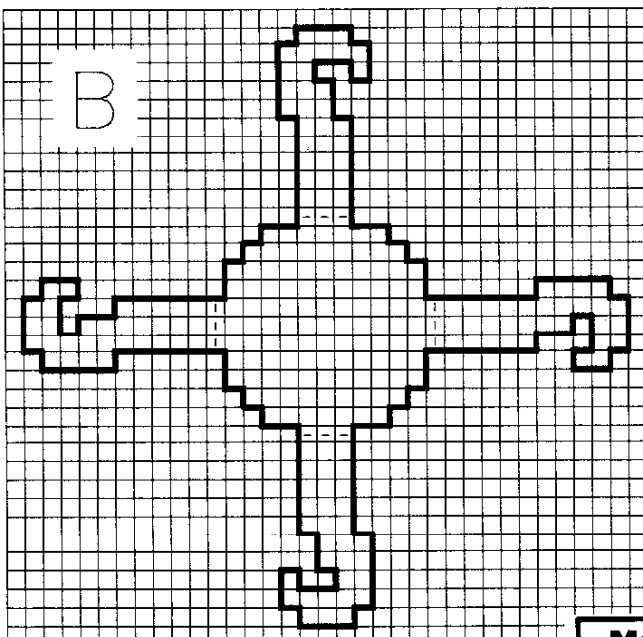
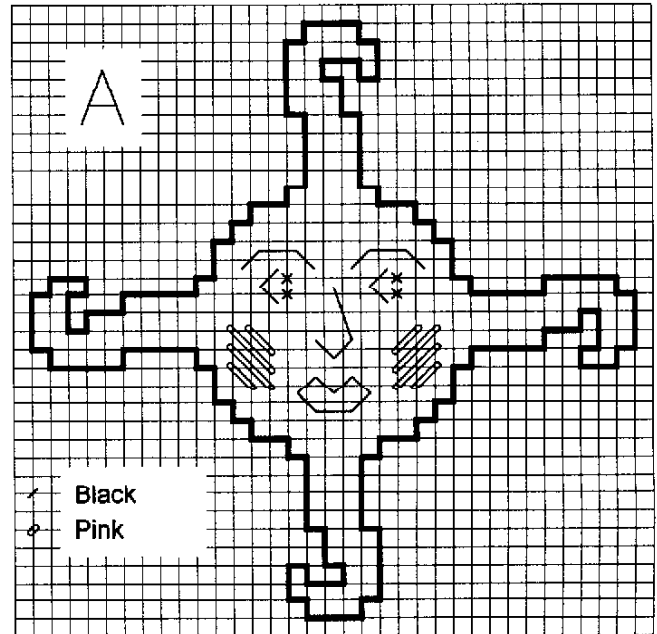
MATERIALS:

¾ sheet—#7 Mesh Plastic Canvas
(Darice Ultimate recommended for best results)
#16 Tapestry Needle
Plastic Canvas Metallic 7 yarn by
Rainbow Gallery
8 yds—PC18 Dark Gold

6 yds—PC7 Yellow Gold
1 yd—PC8 Pink
Plastic Canvas Metallic 10 yarn by Rainbow Gallery
1 yd—PM61 Black
Glue Gun

OR choose your own colors

1. Cut two pieces 33 holes x 33 holes and one piece 31 holes by 31 holes. Trim the larger pieces one each for Chart A and B. Trim the smaller piece for Chart C.
2. On Piece A, work the cheeks in Slanted Diagonal Stitches. Work the background in Yellow Gold Continental Stitches. Overcast all edges with Dark Gold. Work face using the Black doing the pupils of the eyes in Cross Stitch and back stitching the other lines.
3. Work the arms only of the rays on Piece B in Continental using Yellow Gold. Overcast the edges of the rays with Dark Gold. Central portion is left unstitched.
4. Overcast only the edges of the rays on Piece C with Dark Gold. Central portion is left unstitched.
5. Glue Piece A on top of Piece B making sure the arms are centered. Glue Piece C underneath, centering its rays between the larger rays.
6. Make a hanger from thread to use as a suncatcher or ornament, or glue to a purchased tote bag or beach tote, if desired.
