





1/3 sheet—#7 Mesh Plastic Canvas
#16 Tapestry Needle

Plastic Canvas Metallic 7 yarn by Rainbow Gallery
6 yds—PC11 Black
5 yds—PC3 Copper
4 yds—PC7 Yellow Gold
1 yd—PC21 Bronze

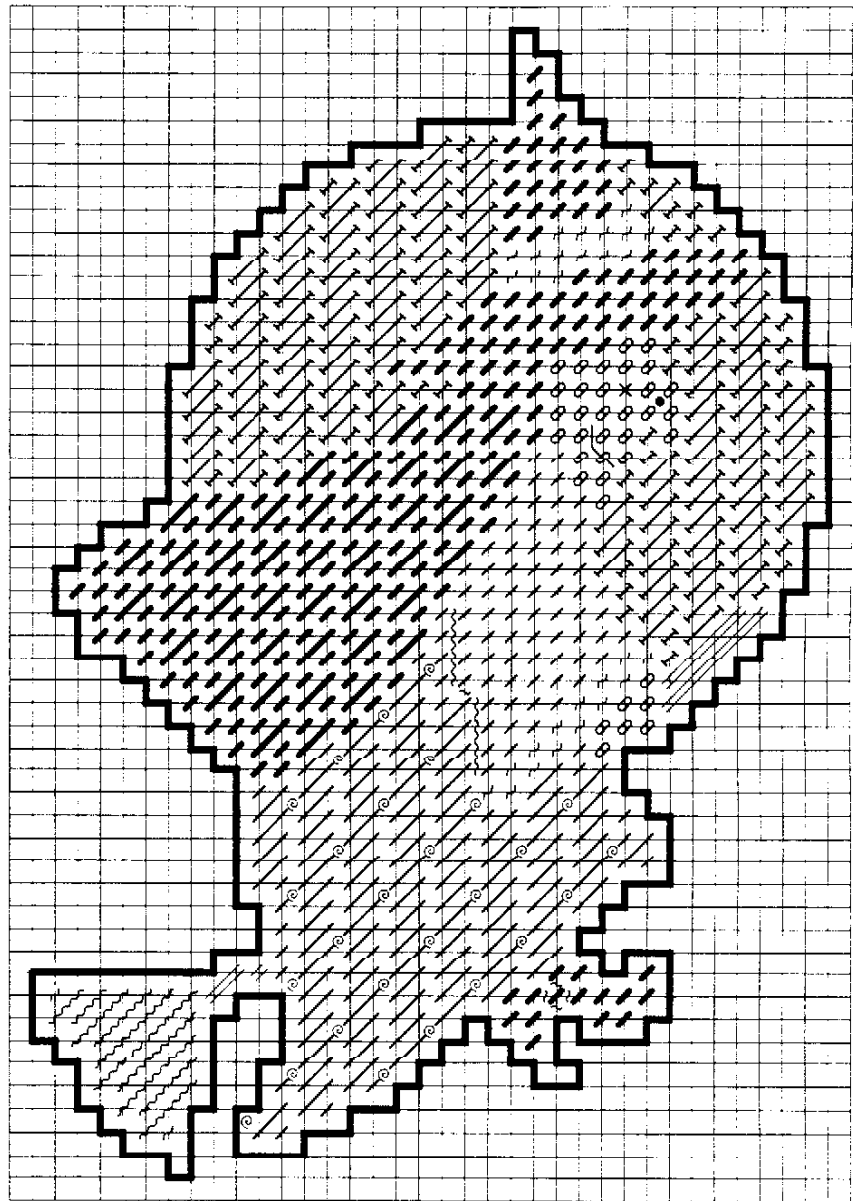
Worsted Weight Yarn
5 yds—Black
1 yd—Sage Green

Small amount of Wavy Wool (from One & Only Creations)

1. Cut one piece 35 holes x 51 holes. Trim according to dark outer line of chart.
2. Work hat, face, hand, sleeve and shoe in Continental Stitch. Work moon and skirt in Glanting Gobelien, Cape in Mosaic Stitch, broom and handle in long straight stitches. Make a Cross Stitch for the eye, French Knots for the wart and dots on the skirt. Backstitch the mouth, sleeve outline and buckle on shoe. Overcast all edges with color adjacent to the edge.
3. Glue the Wavy Wool to the back of the head and under the brim of the hat for the witch's hair. Cut a 7" piece of yarn and glue to the top back side to use as an ornament or glue to a fall wreath as an accent.
