MATERIALS

1/3 sheet—#7 Mesh Plastic Canvas
 #16 Tapestry Needle
 Plastic Canvas Metallic 7 by Rainbow Gallery

RED ORNAMENT

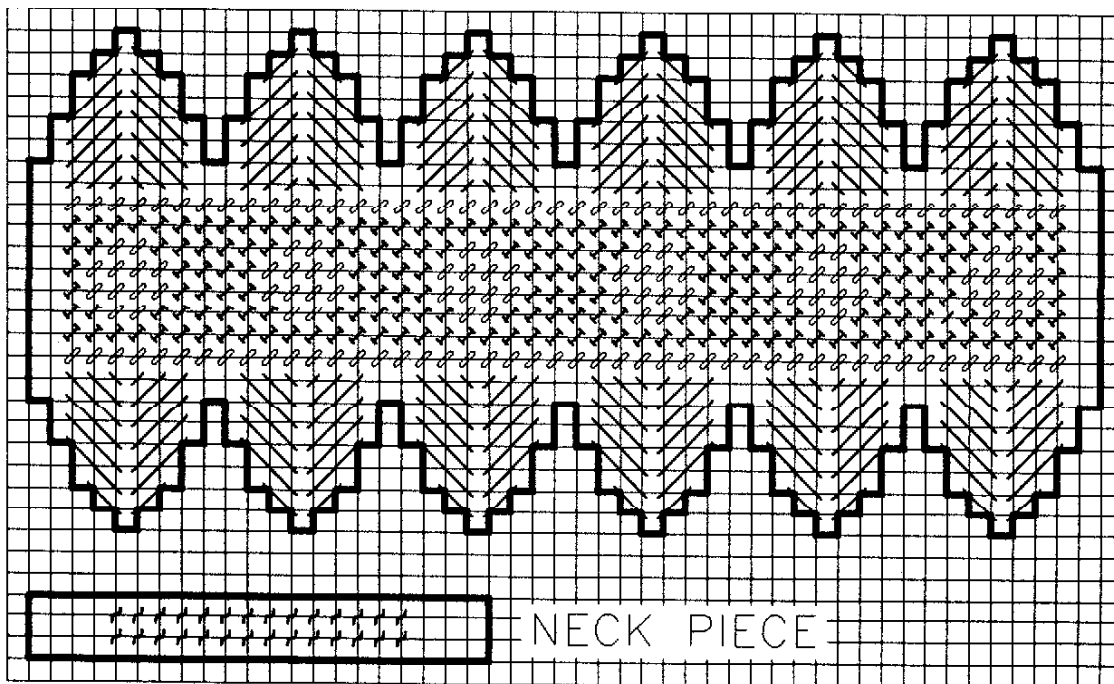
10 yds—PC5 Red
 5 yds—PC4 Green
 3 yds—PC10 White Pearl
 1 yd—PC1 Gold

WHITE ORNAMENT

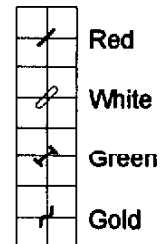
10 yds—PC10 White Pearl
 5 yds—PC5 Red
 4 yds—PC1 Gold

For additional ornaments, create your own color combinations.

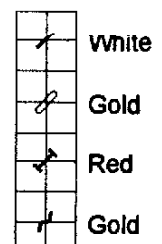
1. Cut plastic canvas as shown below. Rows with no symbols are joining rows.
2. Stitch as shown using the Slanted Gobelin Stitch for the red and gold and the Continental Stitch for the green and white.
3. Overlap ball on unstitched rows and join the two pieces together with Continental Stitches, matching the color in the area. With red, join edges of points to form a ball.
4. Overlap neck piece on unstitched rows and join the two pieces together with gold Continental Stitches. Overcast edges with gold.
5. Glue neck to top of ornament, centering it over the hole. Cut a 10" piece of thread and thread it through neck. Knot the thread together to form a loop for hanging.
